CLERK'S PRACTICE DIRECTIVE NO. 2

RE: COSTS WITH RESPECT TO WRITS OF EXECUTION

There is some issue as to what costs are allowed upon the issuance of a Writ of Execution, specifically, what amount can be claimed on the back page of the Writ in space "... and the sum of \$ _____ for this writ:".

Rule 500 (1) directs that "the fees and expenses of execution" be levied on the Writ. Accordingly, the amount to be filed in on a writ to be issued will include; \$15.00 filing fee to Supreme Court, \$35.00 for filing fee to the Sheriff, as well as the applicable fee to be recovered under Schedule A, item #43.

If there are further fees or costs with respect to the Writ, they will have to be claimed for in a Supplemental Bill of Costs.
