CLERK'S PRACTICE DIRECTIVE NO. 3

CERTIFICATES OF SUBSISTING EXECUTIONS

Rule 525(1) of the Supreme Court rules states "... shall include a statement listing the subsisting writs of executions..."

Section 6(1) of the Creditors Relief Act requires the filing of a "certificate of the Sheriff .. certifying the total amount of subsisting executions .. **as at the day on which the garnishee summons is to be issued...**"

Whit these excerpts in mind, there are three options when filing Garnishee Summonses:

- 1) Include the Original Sheriff's certificate **in** the garnishee summons to be issued.
- 2) Type the list of executions **on** the Garnishee and separately file the Sheriff's Certificate.
- 3) Include a copy of the Sheriff's Certificate **in** the Garnishee Summons and separately file the Sheriff's Certificate.
