**What happens at a default hearing?**

At a default hearing, the judge may

- a. confirm the terms of a payment schedule or other order;
- b. change the terms of a payment schedule or other order in any manner that the judge thinks is fair to the debtor and the creditor; or
- c. cancel the payment schedule.

**What happens if you do not attend?**

The judge may issue a WARRANT OF ARREST for your arrest.

This SUMMONS has no effect unless signed and dated by a judge or a clerk of the Territorial Court.
