





CLERK'S PRACTICE DIRECTIVE

As a result of the coming into force on November 1, 2012 of certain amendments to the *Rules of the Supreme Court of the Northwest Territories*, the following Clerk's Practice Directives are repealed effective November 1, 2012:

1. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 1 - "Filing Pursuant to Rule 11" (July 23, 1996).
2. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 2 - "Costs with Respect to writs of Execution" (July 23, 1996).
3. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 3 - "Certificates of Subsisting Executions" (July 23, 1996).
4. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 4 - "Default Procedure - Rule 160" (July 29, 1996).
5. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 5 - "Offers to Settle" (November 19, 1996 and May 4, 1998).
6. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 6 - "Notice of Withdrawal" (November 19, 1996).
7. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 7 - "Notice of Discontinuance" (November 19, 1996).
8. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 10 - "Notice of Payment into Court" (March 5, 1998).
9. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 11 - "Service by Registered Mail" (January 21, 1999).
