- 7. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 7 "Notice of Discontinuance" (November 19, 1996).
- 8. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 10 "Notice of Payment into Court" (March 5, 1998).
- 9. Clerk's Practice Directive No. 11 "Service by Registered Mail" (January 21, 1999).
