IF YOU DO NOT file and serve the Notice of Objection or court application WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS and there is no court order prohibiting the child(ren)'s relocation, then the relocation can go ahead without further court order on or after the date indicated in the Notice of Relocation.

IF YOU HAVE AN ORDER FOR CONTACT WITH THE CHILD(REN): If you have an order granting you contact with the child(ren) you cannot object to the child(ren)'s relocation.
