NOTICE TO THE PROFESSION

Civil Practice - Enforcement of Existing Orders in Nunavut

Attached is a fiat issued by the Court on today's date providing that existing judgments and orders of the Court are enforceable in Nunavut, unless otherwise ordered.

Any party that seeks relief from this general direction may apply to have the direction set aside with respect to a specific judgment or order. Such an application should be made on notice returnable in regular Chambers.

Any party wishing to enforce or execute a judgment or order should

- a) obtain a certified copy of the judgment, order or writ from the Clerk of the Supreme Court,
- b) attach thereto a copy of the Court's fiat of today's date,
- c) deliver these documents to, or file them with, the proper officers of the Nunavut Territory.

ISSUED this 1st day of April 1999 by direction of the judges of the Supreme Court.
